The American University in Bulgaria is committed to international cooperation in the areas of student, faculty, and staff mobility and research. A key element of the University's Mission Statement is a commitment to diversity, inclusion, and respect in an international academic community and international mobility is an integral component in achieving our mission.

Finding appropriate partners is also an important part of our international strategy for the future. We currently have a joint Executive MBA program in Finance Banking, and Real Estate with the SDA Bocconi School of Management. We are a long time member of the Erasmus + network, as well as the international ISEP consortium for student exchange. Our faculty participate in the Global Liberal Arts Alliance, an international partnership of colleges and universities advancing liberal arts education. Our long standing partnerships worldwide are supported throughout the University and are deeply valued by faculty, students, and staff.
