

GRANT SUPPORT FOR THE MOBILITY OF STUDENTS

for Erasmus+ mobility for study

Students will receive an EU grant as a contribution to their costs for travel and subsistence during the period of their study mobility abroad. The Programme Countries are divided into the three following groups and the monthly grant for each group is fixed:

| Countries | Monthly grant |
|---|---------------|
| Group 1 countries (high cost of living) Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Ireland, Sweden, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Norway | 600 Euro |
| Group 2 countries (medium cost of living) Austria, Belgium, Germany, Greece, Spain, Cyprus, France, Netherlands, Portugal, Slovenia, Malta | 600 Euro |
| Group 3 Countries (low cost of living) Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Republic of North Macedonia, Turkey, Serbia | 540 Euro |

The Erasmus Grant is paid in two installments to the student's personal bank account (In Euro) as follows:

Remark: The grant for Erasmus+ mobility for traineeships is 150 Euro more per month than the grant for studies

1st Grant instalment- 80 % of the total amount paid in advance before the student's departure to the Host Institution

Final Grant instalment- the rest of the eligible amount of the Erasmus grant according to the actual duration of the student mobility - paid after the submission of all required documents at the end of the student Erasmus+ mobility
